Overview of the Neighborhood Safety Workgroup

The Neighborhood Safety Workgroup is a sub-committee of the San Diego County Meth Strike Force (MSF). MSF recognizes that methamphetamine availability and use affects health and public safety in ways that are directly related to neighborhood safety. The NSW focuses on reducing the impacts of meth in communities by increasing collaboration and partnership between prevention providers, law enforcement, multi-housing property management, and multi-housing residents.

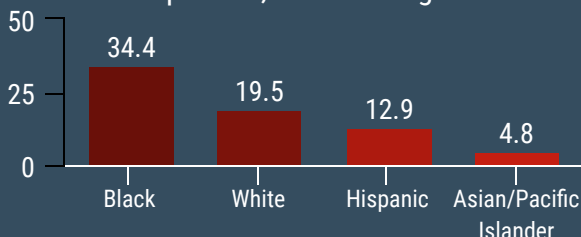
